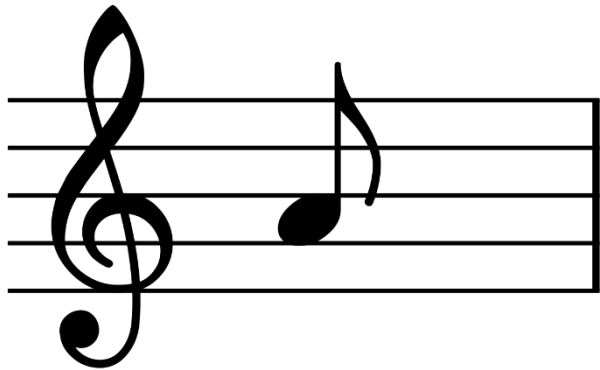
- Monday 4th June – Friday 15th June (First week back after half term & before Osmington Bay trip)

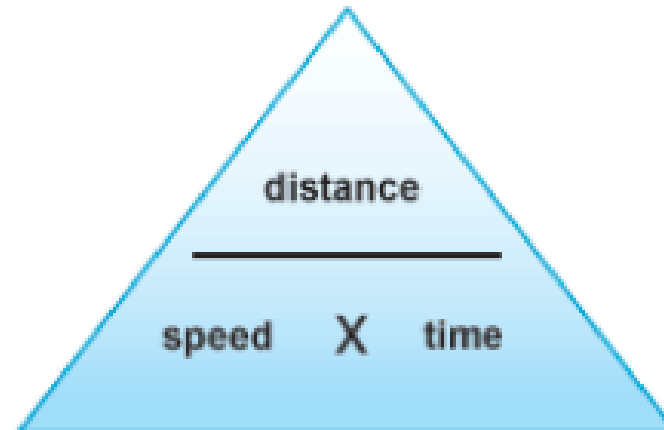
Science
