Subject	Assessment Style/Content
Art	No end of year assessment – Students assessed on art work throughout the year.
Design Technology	No end of year assessment – Students assessed on projects throughout the year.
Drama	Assessed in lessons
English	Two assessments: Reading/Comprehension assessment – Fiction passage – Find facts, explore use of language (PEEL/PETAL paragraphs), impressions, agree about impressions the writer wants to create etc Writing assessment – Descriptive or narrative writing – Given a source (picture) and write a description or story
Geography	Assessment on the topics of: India and geographical skills.
History	No end of year assessment - Students assessed using Covey Packs in lessons.
IT and Computing	Scratch programming assessment currently taking place in lessons
Maths	Two assessments: Monday 4 th June = Non Calculator paper & Wednesday 6 th June = Calculator paper. Content is from chapters 1 to 14 of Kerboodle.
MFL	Variety of assessments: Listening and reading comprehension test, Writing test, Translation test, Short speaking test * Top Tip for band 4/5s – Use Present and future tenses & be able to talk about themselves and other people using 5 different verbs. Also it is essential students have the opportunity to speak in a foreign language.
Music	Two assessments. 1. Practical Grade from their last performance and composition topic. 2. Listening paper, to include; Musical Elements, Pitch Notation, Programme Music and African Music.
Science	Assessment to cover topics such as: Cells, body systems, reproduction, particles, elements, atoms, compounds, reactions, acids and alkalis, forces, sound, light & space. Also Activate 1 (digital textbook) for help with questions linked to areas of working scientifically.
PE	No end of year assessment – Students assessed on two sports every half term.
RE	Assessment to include topics: Introduction to world religions & world religions and the environment. * Top Tip: Use key language, examples and a range of views, both moral and religious to achieve full marks.
