What is Adviza?

Adviza is a registered charity inspiring people to make better decisions that help them progress in learning and work. Our passion is to support young people and others at important times in their lives where key decisions have to be made.

What is the role of a Careers Coach?

This careers adviser in school provides one-to-one or group support to year 11 students through one-to-one meetings, group sessions, assemblies and during PSHE lessons.

Why are students taken out of lessons for Adviza interviews?

Our intention is to help find the right post-16 options for all students and guide them in the right direction. We also see many Year 10s and students from other years that may need some additional support.

Who can refer to Adviza?

We see as many Year 11 students we can but prioritise at the request of any member of staff in school and are happy to have referrals from staff if they feel a one-to-one guidance interview would be beneficial, or parent /carers can also email the school and request support.
