Apprentice Catering Assistants required to support with food preparation, food production, serving, health & safety and cleaning requirements. This role will involve 'on the job' training to become an efficient Catering Assistant and be passionate about progressing on to becoming an experienced Chef/Chef Manager.

Desired skills - Good communication and listening skills. Ability to follow verbal and written technical instruction regarding the creation of our menu products.

Personal qualities - Hard working and reliable with a positive approach and a warm and friendly personality with a passion for good quality food and great customer service.

Qualifications required - Basic standard of secondary education.

Things to consider - This will involve most of the day working on your feet, helping with deliveries, carrying and lifting stock to and from service areas. This kind of environment is fast paced, where employees need to ensure everything is ready for serving the customers at the correct times. You will be working toward a Level 2 NVQ and BTEC and will also complete Level 1 Functional Skills in both Math's and English.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION APPRENTICESHIP Intermediate (level 2)

APPRENTICE IN CHILD CARE Intermediate (Level 2)

You will work four days a week at your nursery setting as a nursery assistant, gaining your practical experience. This will involve a range of activities from arts and crafts to singing and outdoor play. You will then attend college once a week to gain your apprenticeship qualification.



Activities include: Maintain accurate and effective children's records; Respond appropriately to issues requiring confidentiality; Support, promote and implement policies relating to diversity and equality; Work well as part of a team; Work with the team to ensure the smooth running of the nursery day; Work in partnership with parents

Desired skills - Previous experience in childcare is not a necessity but can help. A genuine interest in wanting to care for children is essential.

Personal qualities - Learners must be caring, professional and able to work well as a team. Good time keeping, patience and enthusiasm are all positive qualities for nursery assistants.

Qualifications/Training - No qualifications are required for this apprenticeship. Functional skills including Maths, English and ICT are covered as part of the apprenticeship as is Paediatric first aid. A clear CRB may be required by the nursery. Advanced Apprenticeship candidates will need a C or above in Maths and English GCSE upon completion of this qualification. You will be working towards a Level 2 Certificate in Children and Young People's Workforce or Level 3 Diploma in children and young People's Workforce depending on previous experience and qualifications.

APPRENTICE HAIRDRESSER INTERMEDIATE (LEVEL 2)

Hairdressing is not a job - it is a vocation. You need to be prepared to work hard and deliver first class customer service even when you may not be feeling at your best. You will be on your feet all day and dealing with clients from all walks of life so if this sound like the sort of challenge you're after

Duties will include general upkeep of the salon, shampooing, assisting stylists, greeting and preparing clients and promoting services and products. Some reception work may also be required. As your skills develop you will be given more responsibility

Desired skills - Are good at working as part of a team; can remember and follow instructions; can anticipate the needs of others; can effectively manage their time; pay attention to detail; work safely.

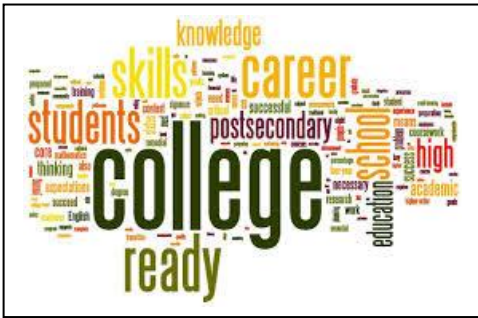
Personal qualities - Punctual and reliable; resilient and determined; well presented; passionate about hairdressing; willing to work hard; the role is physically demanding; pleasant personality; able to keep calm under pressure; are motivated and keen to learn.

Qualifications required - GCSE grades A* to C in English and maths or equivalent.

After achieving NVQ level 2 and completing your Intermediate Apprenticeship you will be encouraged to progress to an Advanced Apprenticeship and to gain NVQ level 3.

APPLYING TO SIXTH FORM OR COLLEGE



If you do not want to apply for any of the apprenticeships above you can prepare for an interview for sixth form or college. If you decide on this option you will need to prepare the following for your interview:

- 1) If you are applying for a specific college course, you will need to do some research and come prepared **as if you are having an interview for that course**. You will need to specify which college course it is on the application form and also use the application form to support your application.
- 2) If you are applying to Edgbarrow sixth form or another sixth form or college to do 'A' levels or BTEC's again **you need to do some research; you also need to specify which 'A' levels or BTECs you are interested in** and again use the application form to indicate in more detail your reasons for those choices.
