## **Part 2**

### **Policy**

1. The Governing Body recognises the statutory duty to provide daily collective worship of a mainly Christian character for all students and chooses to discharge this responsibility as described in this policy.
2. The Headteacher will ensure that there is a weekly assembly for each year group. The purpose of assemblies will be to:
  - Reinforce the values of the school community, its ethos and to set standards
  - Celebrate success
  - Give students the opportunity to reflect
  - Consider spiritual and moral issues
3. Alternative provision will be made for students whose parents/carers request that they do not attend assemblies which have a religious element.

### **Arrangements for monitoring and evaluation**

4. The Governing Body will receive an annual report on the themes covered for all assemblies during the academic year.
