Discretionary Bursary information

Edgbarrow School administers this funding scheme for Sixth Form students on behalf of the DfE. Each year we are allocated an amount (based on previous eligible student numbers) and we share this out with those students who are eligible to receive it. The amount allocated per student will depend on the total number of eligible students. Students can use their bursary money for the following:

- Purchasing books and equipment
- School trips (residential trips by negotiation)
- Travel costs
- Cucina / Pronto purchases

Eligibly criteria:

- Household total income of £30,000 per annum or less
- Entitlement to UK residency with a UK / EU passport

We would like to stress that all students' applications will be dealt with in confidence and with discretion and sensitivity.

Please ensure that applications for this academic year are handed to Caroline Light in the Sixth form office by Friday 22nd September so that we can process them as soon as possible.

Vulnerable Students' Bursary information

Some students have exceptional circumstances and are automatically entitled to an annual sum of £1,200. We apply for this on behalf of the students and it is separate funding from that in the discretionary scheme.
